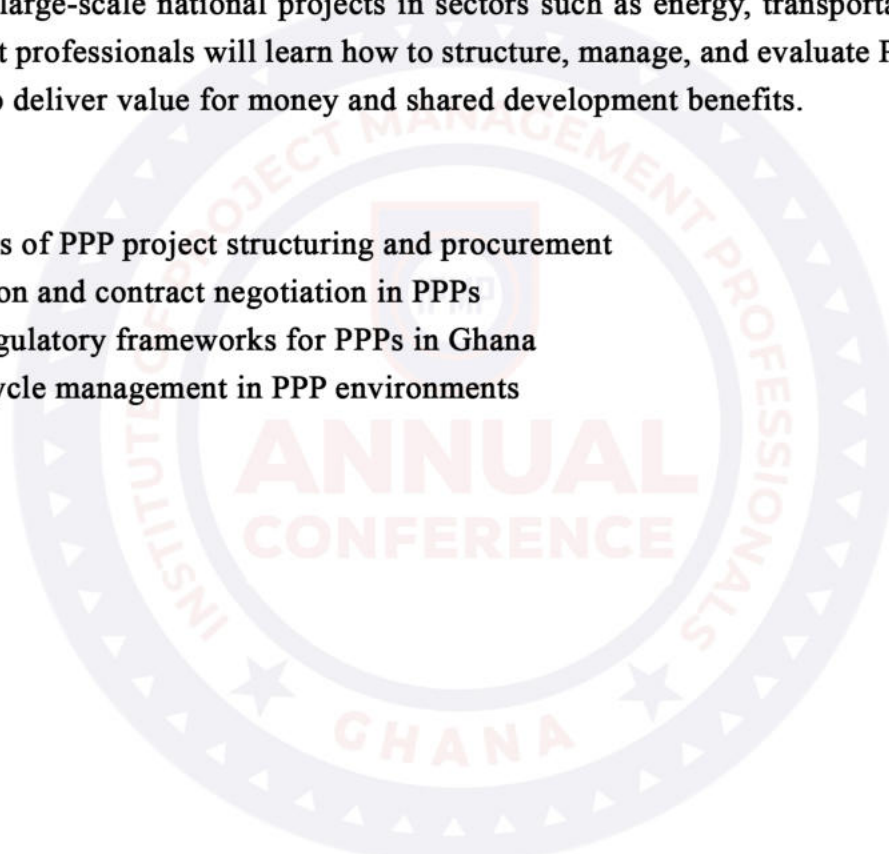
THEMATIC AREAS FOR THE 2025 IPMP ANNUAL WORKSHOP

- Project lifecycle management in PPP environments





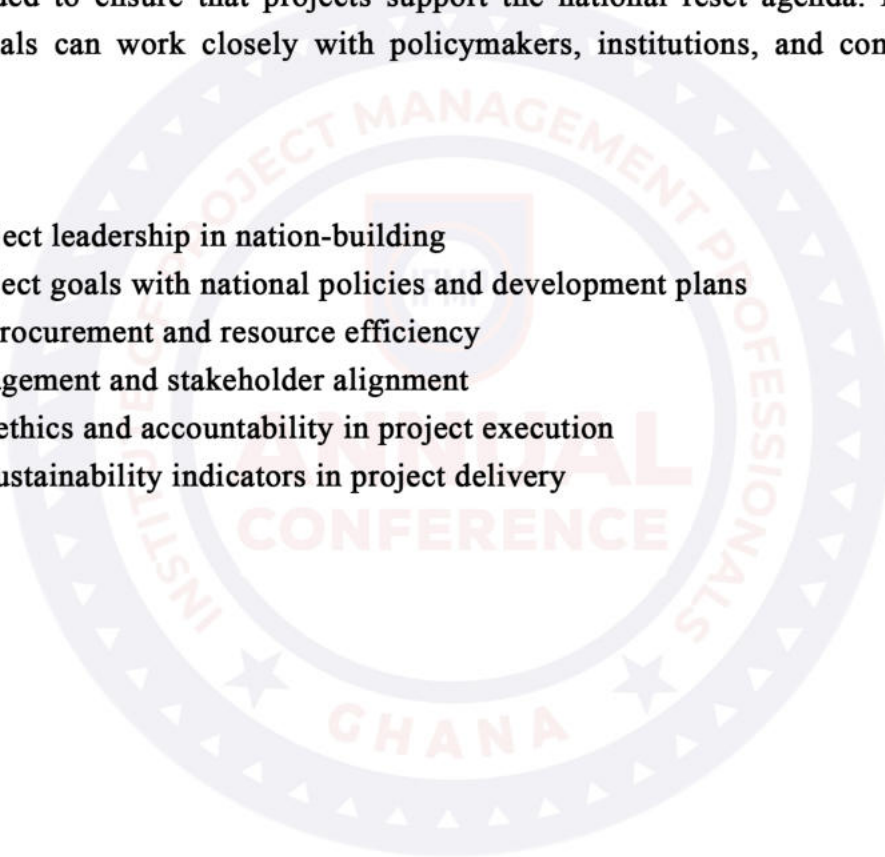
THEMATIC AREAS FOR THE 2025 IPMP ANNUAL WORKSHOP

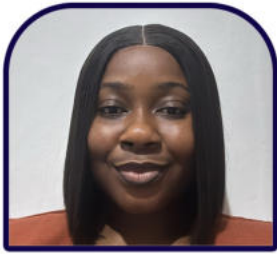
